If you missed ordering through the school you will need to go to a local music store or an on-line retailer and purchase a "Baroque Soprano Recorder." There are many kinds, but this is a beginner recorder and all of the curriculum I use requires this recorder specifically. We have started the year reviewing Solfege, the language of singing, and Notation, the language of written music. Reading, writing, and playing all go together to develop musicality in students.
